# Monday

**All:**


**Dear Jesus,**

Let's say together:



Let's say together:


**All:**

Let's say together:



But I said to myself, "*Nothing is impossible for God.*"

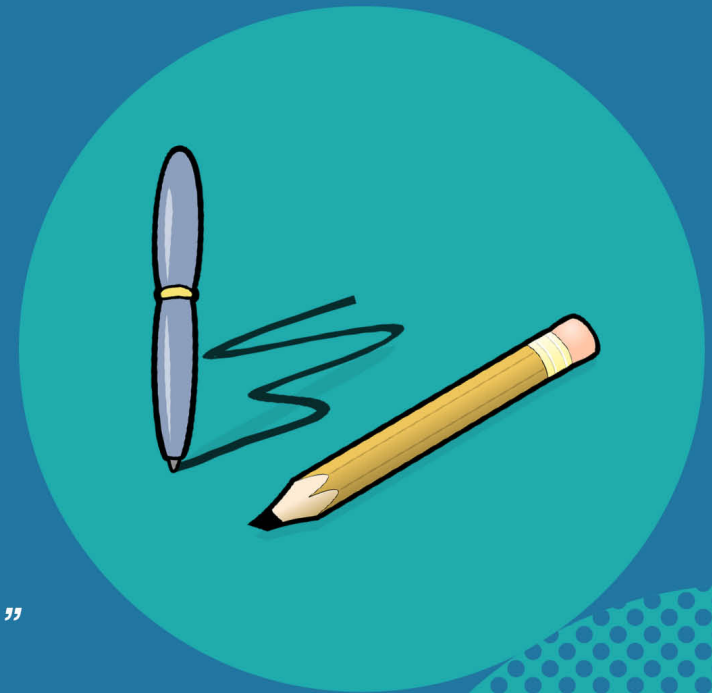
And I remembered that God loves me no matter what I do.

Let's say together:


