On Sunday it was the Feast of Christ the King, which is a celebration at the end of the Liturgical Year.


Just like we celebrate the passing of one calendar year to the next, the Feast of Christ the King celebrates the changing of one of Liturgical Year to the next.

Each day we'll consider what is important to us, and ask Jesus to be the king of our hearts.


