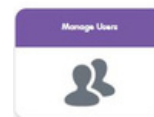

TOP TIPS

Did you know you can add additional users to the portal?

Select My School and then Manage users



Manage Users allows you to add new users and deactivate accounts for people who may have left. You won't however be able to deactivate your own account. You will need to contact a member of the support team to do this for you.

If you are unable to create a new user in this way, please ask your Head teacher to contact our support team to authorise the request and we can set it up for you.

PAYMENT INFORMATION

As you are aware, part of the agreement for support under the NSBP is that schools are asked to contribute 25% towards the supply and delivery of breakfast food from start of term August/September 2022 to July 2023.

We would like to thank everyone that has submitted their details on the portal so far. If you have not already done so, we would appreciate you setting up your payment details as soon as possible, however you will not be charged until after July 2022. There is the option to pay by invoice or direct debit. It is really important that you choose your method of payment as without it we will not be able to deliver your orders from the Autumn Term.

If your School Business Manager or Finance Manager wants to log into the site to complete this, you can set them up as an additional user on the portal. See our top tip for more information.
