


- Reading books All children should read every school night. This should be recorded by an adult in personal reading records.
- Reading sources can be a wide range of literature including magazines, internet, news articles, comics, novels and poetry.
- Books to be taken home on a Monday and returned to school on a Friday.











- Children will bring their homework book home every Monday. It should be returned on Friday mornings.
- Each week will consist of four activities: times tables, spellings and consolidation activities of both maths and English.
- Homework is important to consolidate learning in class and prepare children for secondary school. Registers will be kept.









Tables and Spellings



- Our weekly spelling tests will take place on Mondays.
- It is important that spellings and times tables are practised every night. 5 minutes a day will really make a difference!
- Children will be given access to the Spelling Shed and Times Table Rockstars websites/apps to help them further develop these skills.
