- Reading sources can be a wide range of literature including magazines, internet, news articles, comics, novels and poetry.

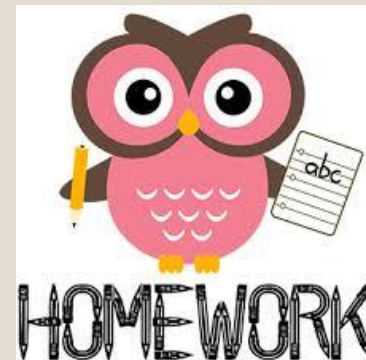
