



Pupil Premium Funding

Help our school to access additional funding that can benefit your child.

Pupil Premium Funding entitles your child to Free School Milk and Meals.

With the amount of money that schools receive falling it is important that we obtain all the funding we can. Registering for pupil premium and free school meals and milk could raise £ £1,455 for our school, to fund valuable support like extra tuition, additional teaching staff or other school activities.

Statistics indicate that more children in our school are entitled to pupil premium, free milk and meals. If you receive any of the following benefits you may be entitled to Pupil Premium Funding.

- + Income Support
- + Income-based jobseekers Allowance
- + Income related Employment and Support Allowance
- + Support from NASS (National Asylum Support Service) under part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- + The guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- + Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit) with an annual income of no more than £16,190
- + Working Tax Credit run-on
- + Universal Credit
